1. Introduction

These Terms and Conditions ('Terms') govern your participation in IBIC 2027 — the International Beauty Innovators Conference and Awards ('the Event'), organized by Henrietta Orosz ('Organizer', 'we', 'us', 'our'). By registering for, attending, or otherwise participating in the Event, you ('Participant', 'you') agree to be bound by these Terms in their entirety.

Please read these Terms carefully before completing your registration. If you do not agree with any part of these Terms, you must not register for or attend the Event.

2. Definitions

- 'Event' means the IBIC 2027 International Beauty Innovators Conference and Awards taking place in Budapest, Hungary on April 3, 2027.
- 'Organizer' means Henrietta Orosz, the legal entity responsible for organizing the Event.
- 'Participant' means any individual who registers to attend, speak, sponsor, exhibit at, or otherwise participate in the Event.
- 'Ticket' means any paid or complimentary registration pass granting access to all or part of the Event.
- 'Website' means the official IBIC website through which registrations, submissions, and information are managed.
- 'Awards' means the IBIC 2027 Awards competition component of the Event, including all categories and judging processes.

3. Registration & Tickets

3.1 Eligibility

The Event is open to beauty professionals, brand representatives, educators, and industry stakeholders. By registering, you confirm that all information you provide is accurate, complete, and up to date.

3.2 Ticket Purchase

All Ticket purchases are subject to availability and are confirmed only upon receipt of full payment. Ticket prices are stated on the Website and are inclusive/exclusive of VAT as indicated. The Organizer reserves the right to alter ticket pricing at any time without notice, except for already-confirmed bookings.

3.3 Ticket Transfers

Tickets are non-refundable. However, you may transfer your Ticket to another individual upon written request submitted latest 14 days after purchase. The substitute attendee must meet all eligibility requirements. A transfer fee may apply.

4. Payment

All payments must be made in full at the time of registration unless a payment plan has been expressly agreed in writing with the Organizer. Accepted payment methods are displayed on the Website. All prices are quoted in EUR unless otherwise stated. The Organizer is not responsible for any currency conversion fees or charges applied by your bank or payment provider.

Where an invoice has been issued, payment is due within 14 days of the invoice date and in any case no later than 30 days before the Event. Unpaid registrations may be cancelled without notice after the due date.

5. No Refund Policy

All Ticket sales are final. Tickets are strictly non-refundable under all circumstances, including but not limited to personal illness, travel disruption, change of plans, or inability to attend for any reason.

By completing your purchase, you acknowledge and accept this no-refund policy. We strongly recommend that all Participants arrange appropriate travel and cancellation insurance prior to booking.

5.1 Ticket Transfer (in lieu of refund)

As an alternative to a refund, you may transfer your Ticket to another eligible individual free of charge, provided the request is submitted in writing to the Organizer latest 14 days after purchasing the tickets to the Event. Transfer requests received later than 14 days after purchase to the Event cannot be guaranteed.

5.2 Cancellation or Postponement by the Organizer

In the exceptional circumstance that the Organizer cancels the Event entirely, registered Participants will receive a full refund of their Ticket price. This is the only circumstance in which a refund will be issued.

In the event of postponement, Tickets will automatically remain valid for the rescheduled date. Participants who cannot attend the rescheduled date may request a refund within 14 days of the postponement announcement.

The Organizer's liability in the event of cancellation or postponement is limited strictly to the face value of the Ticket purchased. The Organizer accepts no responsibility for travel, accommodation, visa, or any other costs incurred by Participants.

6. Code of Conduct

All Participants are expected to conduct themselves professionally and respectfully throughout the Event. The Organizer operates a zero-tolerance policy towards harassment, discrimination, intimidation, or any behaviour that creates an unsafe or uncomfortable environment for others.

The Organizer reserves the right to remove any Participant from the Event at any time without refund if, in the Organizer's reasonable opinion, that Participant is behaving in a manner inconsistent with these standards or is causing disruption.

7. Intellectual Property

All content presented at the Event, including but not limited to presentations, demonstrations, written materials, and branding, remains the intellectual property of the respective presenters or the Organizer. Participants may not record, reproduce, distribute, or publish any Event content without prior written consent from the relevant rights holder.

The IBIC name, logo, and associated branding are the exclusive property of the Organizer. Unauthorized use of these marks is strictly prohibited.

8. Photography & Recording

By attending the Event, you consent to being photographed, filmed, or otherwise recorded for promotional, marketing, archival, or editorial purposes. Such images or recordings may be used by the Organizer across print, digital, and social media channels without further consent or compensation. If you object to being photographed, please notify event staff on arrival.

9. Liability

The Organizer takes all reasonable steps to ensure the safety and smooth running of the Event. However, to the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, the Organizer shall not be liable for any indirect, incidental, consequential, or special damages arising out of or in connection with the Event, including loss of earnings, loss of opportunity, or personal injury, except where caused by the Organizer's gross negligence or willful misconduct.

Participants attend the Event at their own risk and are responsible for their own personal property and safety. The Organizer recommends that all Participants arrange appropriate travel and cancellation insurance.

10. Force Majeure

The Organizer shall not be held liable for any failure or delay in the performance of its obligations where such failure or delay is caused by circumstances beyond the Organizer's reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, natural disasters, pandemics, governmental action, war, civil unrest, or venue failure. In such circumstances, the Organizer will make all reasonable efforts to reschedule the Event and will communicate updates to Participants promptly.

11. Governing Law & Jurisdiction

These Terms are governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Hungary. Any disputes arising from or in connection with these Terms shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Budapest, Hungary.

12. Amendments

The Organizer reserves the right to amend these Terms at any time. Material changes will be communicated to registered Participants by email. Continued participation in the Event following notification of changes constitutes acceptance of the revised Terms.
